L'ARCHE International began in 1964 in Trosley-Breuil, France, when Jean Vanier took two handicapped men, Raphael and Philip into his home. L'ARCHE is French for "The Ark" meaning a place of refuge. L'ARCHE has grown to become an international organization with 135 communities in 31 countries. L'ARCHE Mobile was established in 1974 and is supported by a local board. The community consisted of four homes and an activity center.
